# ABOUT KSDC

Kingdom Seekers Day Camp is a Christian day camp for children 3 years old through those entering 7th grade.

## KSDC HOURS: 8AM to 3PM

Drop off begins at 8 AM and goes until 9 AM. Pick up starts at 2:30. At 3:15 PM campers will go into After Care.

After care is available until 5PM for an additional fee.

# TIERED PRICING

KSDC is committed to ensuring that every child has the opportunity to benefit from the transformative experience of summer camp, irrespective of their financial situation. Tiered pricing is a system that allows for different price points (tiers) for each camper. The idea behind a tiered system is to recognize that different families have different financial means, and to let families pay what they feel they are able to. Families who can afford to support camp and pay the highest tier pricing, make it possible for KSDC to offer a lower rate for those families who can't afford rising prices in a tough economy.

This is an honor based system. You may choose the tier that is best suited for your situation. Every camper will receive the same experience regardless of what tier is selected!

**Tier 1: \$105** This option allows families, regardless of income, to provide their child with this enriching experience.

**Tier 2: \$125** This tier more accurately represents the actual costs to Laurel Hill Bible Church to cover the cost of a child at Kingdom Seekers Day Camp.

**Tier 3: \$145** This tier gives you the opportunity to help supplement the cost of camp for families who can't afford it and help grow the ministry of Kingdom Seekers Day Camp.

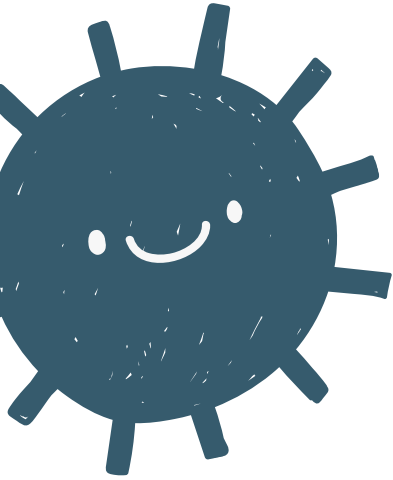

# DROP OFF / PICK UP

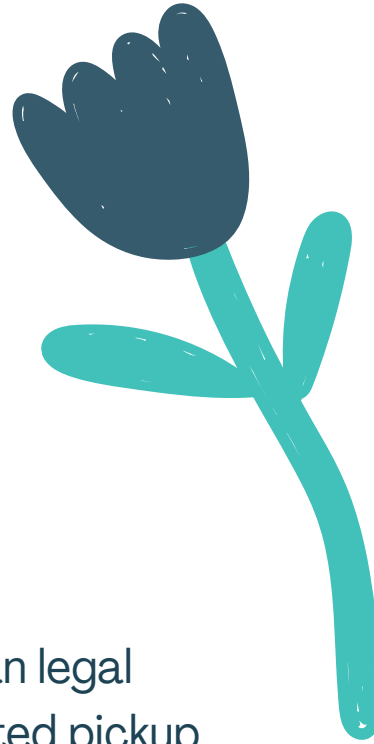
## Drop Off

## Pick Up Policy

Campers will not be released to anyone other than legal guardian(s) unless the individual is listed as a designated pickup person on the camper's registration form. If a camper is being picked up by a person that has not been listed, the Camp Director requires prior notification. Please advise any individual picking up your camper that they will be asked for a government-issued photo I.D.

## Early Departures

Early departures should be arranged with KSDC staff with advance notice so that the staff can communicate an appropriate location for pickup. In the event of an emergency, please call us to arrange pick up.

## Does KSDC do field trips?

## Is there a nurse on site?

KSDC has a Health Director who has completed CPR/First Aid/AED certification for professional rescuers. In addition, our Head Counselors are also CPR/First Aid/AED certified.

# KSDC Camper Code of Conduct

**Dear Parents and Campers,**

We are so excited to have you join this summer! KSDC is dedicated to providing a safe and fun summer camp experience for youth. Campers are expected to behave appropriately and promote a safe, fun and healthy environment. The staff is will work with campers to encourage positive behavior and participation. If a behavioral issues arises, staff will reach out to the parent to discuss how the issue can be remedied. Participants who remain disruptive after consultation with the parents may be dismissed from the program with no refund. Please review the Code of Conduct below with your child so that he/she fully understands the expectations.

As a camper, I am expected to:

- Show respect to other participants, and treat them as well as I would like to be treated.
- Follow instructions and listen to KSDC Counselors.
- Be respectful of KSDC's equipment, facilities, and grounds.
- Not use profanity, offensive language or name-calling
- Never use physical aggression, e.g. hitting, kicking, pulling, fighting, spitting, etc.
- Have fun!

At KSDC, discipline will be offered in love with the goal of restoring relationships with a safe and peaceful atmosphere.

1. We will remove the camper (or campers) from the situation.
2. We will communicate concern and listen to the explanation of what happened.
3. We will counsel the camper in strategies for changing the inappropriate behavior.
4. Serious inappropriate behavior will be reported to parents and may require the child leaving camp (Example: bullying, inappropriate touching, repeated unacceptable behavior)

Kingdom Seekers Day Camp reserves the right to send campers home without refund for unacceptable behavior.
